

What is CLIC?


The Care Leaver Independent Collective (CLIC) are a group of Care Experienced Young People who help to shape the care system for future Children and Young People.

We have met 24 times this year at The Oasis Hub. Our meetings last around 2 hours.

We meet face to face but can offer a virtual option for any young person who lives out of the city!

This year 11 young people have engaged with CLIC, with an average of 6 people attending each meeting

New for 2024, our meetings have moved to Thursday evenings!

CLIC: Ongoing projects

- Oral health review- Members of CLIC have attended to develop clearer pathway for care leavers to access dentists.
- Total Respect train the trainer- 2 members of CLIC have took part in training to become more confident in delivering total respect.
- Corporate Parenting Board- Annual Report feedback CLIC Received an overview of the plans from the Corporate Parenting Board
- Staying Close Conference- CLIC have been kept up to date with the staying close Project, members attended the celebration event of the staying close project at the Molineux on 16th July 2024.
- Participation Policy CLIC inputted into the development of the revised policy.
- Care Leavers Survey Update 2024- CLIC were involved in shaping the survey and ensuring that their members and other care leavers completed.



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CLIC: Ongoing projects

- Little House Childrens Home- CLIC members have been involved in the shaping of policies and procedures and pre inspections
- Development of the local offer for Care Leavers in Custody
- Care Leavers Month Have developed plans for this with members attending the Care Leavers Week events.

Free bus pass access for all Wolverhampton Care Leavers within Black Country for 12 Months

Increased Wi-F access for Care Leavers, including access to Social Value contracts and better wi-fi access in supported accommodation flats.

Developed a Care Leavers Offer for Over 25s, including a monthly drop-in session.

Working closely with REACH Team to continue to develop Local Offer

Promote and support widening the care leavers transport offer with the backing of West Midlands Transport.

Increase format of communication to increase engagement and participation with CLIC

Oral health - to review the progress of the oral health pathway.
