The Care Leaver Independence Collective are a group of care experienced Young People who help to shape the care system for future service users. They are involved with policy changes for children and young people in care and care leavers, delivering training, and getting the voices of Young People heard.

We meet twice a month (the first and third Wednesday). The group enables you to gain skills like confidence. The forum sometimes invites key members to their meetings like Councillors, Social Workers enabling you to voice your concerns.

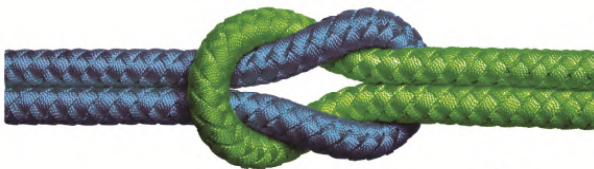
