Before you turn 25:

 If you have remained engaged with the service, you will have an up to date final plan completed within the 6 months prior to you turning 25.

• You will be written to prior to turning 25 with a

'next steps' letter which will contain relevant local

contacts for you.

• We will celebrate turning 25 with you if you remain actively engaged in the service. This should not be seen as a 'goodbye' but a celebration of achievement and an opportunity for reflection on how far you have come.

We will continue to be a point of contact for you at any age, we can offer you with advice, guidance and signposting to relevant services.





We will host a monthly 'cake and catch up' drop in on the first Wednesday of every month between 10-12 at the Oasis Hub offering a more flexible drop in and catch up. Pop in and tell us how you are getting on.
